

"911" Street Numbering System Ordinance

The WEA Building Committee wishes to inform the WE property owners that the Towns of Campton and Thornton have adopted a Street Numbering System Ordinance.

All Waterville Estates Village District property owners have been assigned numbers which must be displayed as follows:

All properties with primary buildings shall display the assigned street number so as to be readily visible from the street:

1. For primary buildings readily visible from the street, the street number shall be conspicuously displayed on that side of the building which faces the street.
2. For primary buildings not readily visible from the street, the assigned street number shall be conspicuously displayed at the main vehicular access to the property, so as to be visible on a year-round basis. The number may be affixed to a sign, post or similar means at the main access.
3. All displayed street numbers shall be of a contrasting color to the means of support such as the primary building or post, etc.
4. All displayed street numbers shall be at least three and one half (3 1/2) inches in height.

The Towns of Campton and Thornton may assess a penalty for non-compliance with this Ordinance not to exceed \$250 for each day of non-compliance.

The WEA Building Committee is suggesting the following guidelines to ensure compliance and that, in cases of fire or emergency, the Campton Fire and Rescue teams be able to find your property in a timely fashion:

1. Use 4-6 inch high, reflective numbers. Samples will be available at the Community Center.
2. Whatever numbers are used, make sure that they contrast with the background and can be readily seen day and night.
3. Snow banks and leafy branches must not obscure the view of the number from the street.
